

Live Semiannual Training Regulations

This is a training, 24 hours a day for 6 days.

1. **Meeting schedule:** There will be two meetings daily at 4:00pm and 7:30pm beginning Monday, June 29, 2026 and concluding after the evening meeting Saturday, July 4, 2026.
2. **Arriving at the LSM Campus:** Come early, come singing, praising, praying, and rejoicing. Be in your seat 5 minutes before meeting times (3:55pm and 7:25pm). Do all greeting, visiting, and fellowshiping outside the building. Once inside the hall, all talking should cease, and there should be only praying, praising, and singing.
3. **Health Consciousness:** To prevent the spread of germs, please avoid shaking hands. Wash or sanitize your hands frequently.
4. **Assigned Seating:** Everyone in this training has an assigned seat and it is against training regulations to offer your seat or name badge to anyone at any time. Please do not sit in any other seat without permission from LSM Registration. If your seat is empty, you will be marked as absent.
5. **During the meeting:** Exercise to receive the word. No talking during the message or testimonies, especially in the back rows. No eating or drinking is allowed during the meeting. You may bring only water into the meeting hall and only in containers that can be sealed. With so many at the training, spills are bound to happen with open containers.
6. **Leaving your seat:** You may not leave your seat during the training meetings. If you leave your seat for any reason before the training meeting is dismissed, including to use the restroom, your seat number will be recorded. If you have an urgent need to sit near a restroom for this training, LSM Registration may be able to reassign you to a seat near the restroom but will still record that you left your seat.
7. **After the message:** Exercise to practice prophesying—please be brief.
8. **Leaving the meeting area:** When the meeting is dismissed, please do not block others by standing and talking in the aisles, in front of the doors, or just outside the doors.
9. **Absences:** Unexcused absences are not allowed and two excused absences is grounds for dismissal from the training.
10. **Testing:** Prepare yourself by using your notes from the messages, outlines, and text of verses.
11. **Study sessions:** All trainees must study for three hours every morning, preferably in groups of 8-10. Rest time is from 1:30-2:30pm. No phone calls during rest time.
12. **Young people's study time:** Study sessions are mandatory for all English-speaking young people (High School through College Age) attending the training. Daily meetings from 9:00am to 11:45am will be held in the Ministry Conference Center at the LSM campus. The responsible ones for the young people from each locality **must** make sure that their young people get back to their hospitality from 12:00-3:00pm each day. Please do not leave any young people at the LSM campus during this time.
13. **Security:** Trainees, especially the sisters, are advised not to walk alone after dark. It is better to walk in groups of two or more to your destination.
14. **Pictures:** Please do not take pictures during any meeting of the training.
15. **Recording:** Recording of the messages (including video recording) is prohibited during all meetings of the training. This includes live streaming of the messages to the Internet, which will be grounds for dismissal from the training.
16. **Note-taking:** No notes taken by hand or by computer can be circulated. They are to be used only by you for review and study purposes. Please note that there is no provision at the LSM campus for you to plug in your laptop or any other electronic device. Please do not use any of the electrical outlets.
17. **Dress Code:** Concerning the matter of dress, we would ask all the saints to let the peace of Christ arbitrate in your hearts and to consider one another in brotherly love.
18. **Cell phones:** Please turn cell phones off during the training meetings.

New and Improved Method for Receiving Language Translation at LSM Live Conferences and Trainings

Living Stream Ministry is now offering a new form of wireless audio translation via Bluetooth broadcast, called Auracast™. Instead of the traditional one-to-one pairing of classic Bluetooth, Auracast allows an unlimited number of compatible receivers to connect simultaneously. No pairing is required. Auracast is superior to FM radio and ListenWiFi as it does not compete with commercial radio stations, there is no need for WiFi, and there is no limit to the number of connections. Initially, Living Stream Ministry will offer Auracast translation for English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese, Korean, and Russian.

To use the Auracast transmission, an **Auracast-enabled headphone/receiver is required**. The following is a list of compatible devices, categorized by type:
